Penang Street Art

Famous murals and street art scattered throughout George Town.

Various locations around George Town, including Armenian Street and Lebuh Cannon

Little India

A vibrant area with Indian shops, eateries, and cultural sights. Around Lebuh Chulia, Lebuh Queen, and Market Street

Clan Jetties

A traditional Chinese waterfront settlement consisting of wooden houses on stilts, offering a glimpse into the lives of the local Chinese community.

Kek Lok Si Temple

Malaysia's largest Buddhist temple, renowned for its stunning architecture, beautiful gardens, and the impressive Kuan Yin statue that offers panoramic views of Penang

Cheong Fatt Tze Mansion (Blue Mansion)

A historic mansion known for its stunning architecture and heritage significance.

A prominent mosque with beautiful Indo-Moorish architecture.

Goddess of Mercy Temple (Kuan Yin Temple)

One of Penang's oldest and most significant Chinese temples.

Fort Cornwallis

A historical fort built by the British East India Company in the late 18th century.

RESTAURANT

Hameediyah Restaurant

Recognized as Penang's oldest nasi kandar restaurant, originally started under a tree at a field in Lebuh Campbell.

Must-try: Murtabak, Nasi Kandar, Chicken Kapitan

Tek Sen Restaurant

Established in 1965, known for its expertly crafted traditional Cantonese dishes and fusion creations with a local twist.

Must-try: Double Roasted Pork, Assam Prawns, Butter Prawns

Restoran Kapitan

Renowned for its authentic North Indian cuisine, especially the delicious Tandoori dishes and fragrant Briyani.

Must-try: Tandoori Chicken, Naan, Briyani

Tai Tong Restaurant

One of Penang's earliest dim sum spots, it has been around since the 1950s.

Must-try: Dim Sum (including steamed buns, dumplings, and other bite-sized delights)

A Penang favorite, Joo Hooi Cafe is known for its authentic Char Koay Teow and flavorful Penang Assam Laksa. Enjoy local dishes in a casual setting, and don't forget to try their refreshing Cendol for dessert.

Chulia Street Night Hawker Stalls

Line Clear Nasi Kandar
